1. Lusaka's Way Forward

In Lusaka consensus was reached on:

- **Checklist of elements for the completion of a country compact**
- **One M&E Framework**
- **Changing development partner behavior, culture and processes**
- **Engagement with the civil society at global and country level**
- **HHA harmonized technical assistance and capacity development support**

High level political advocacy



2. Achievements since Lusaka (1)

- In Africa, three country compacts have been signed: Ethiopia, Mozambique and Mali.
- Increasing engagement of new signatories of the IHP+ Global Compact (most recently, Rwanda, Uganda, Nigeria, Madagascar and Niger)
- Increased engagement of Civil Society at global level and in the Country Health Teams
- Agreement on common results frameworks and on attributes for appraisal of national health strategies

2. Achievements (2)

- **High level political advocacy**
 - **HHA Ministerial Meeting in Ouagadougou, April 2008**
 - **IHP+ Ministerial Meeting during WHA 2008**
 - **AFRO Regional Committee, September 2008**
 - **Accra Forum on Aid Effectiveness, September 2008**
 - **IHP+ Ministerial Review Meeting, February 2009 and its Communiqué**



3. Challenges

Assessment of the IHP+ compact implementation in Ethiopia (Jan. 2009) highlighted challenges that may relate also to other countries:

- At country level, number and degree of development partners' participation and commitment is relatively low
- Technical capacity of both government and development partners at operational level is low and overstretched
- Limited use of technical networks and assistance for impact under the present resource constraints

4. Country Experiences

Efforts/difficulté/opportunités/ Défis

- Progrès vers l'atteinte des OMDs mais des efforts importants au regard des échéances

- Insuffisances dans le soutien au renforcement des systèmes de santé et les SSP globale

- Persistance de certains partenaires à soutenir uniquement des programmes verticaux
- Non disponibilité des ressources additionnelles nécessaires

Efforts/difficulté/opportunités/ Défis

- Beaucoup d'efforts élaboration de documents de politique, de plans stratégiques, d'outils CDMT, évaluation conjointe plan nationaux Costings
- Disponibilités orientations clairs renouveau SSP, déterminant santé, MPS
- Beaucoup d'initiatives pour soutenir: études,
- Les pays sont prêts pour renforcer la mise en oeuvre
