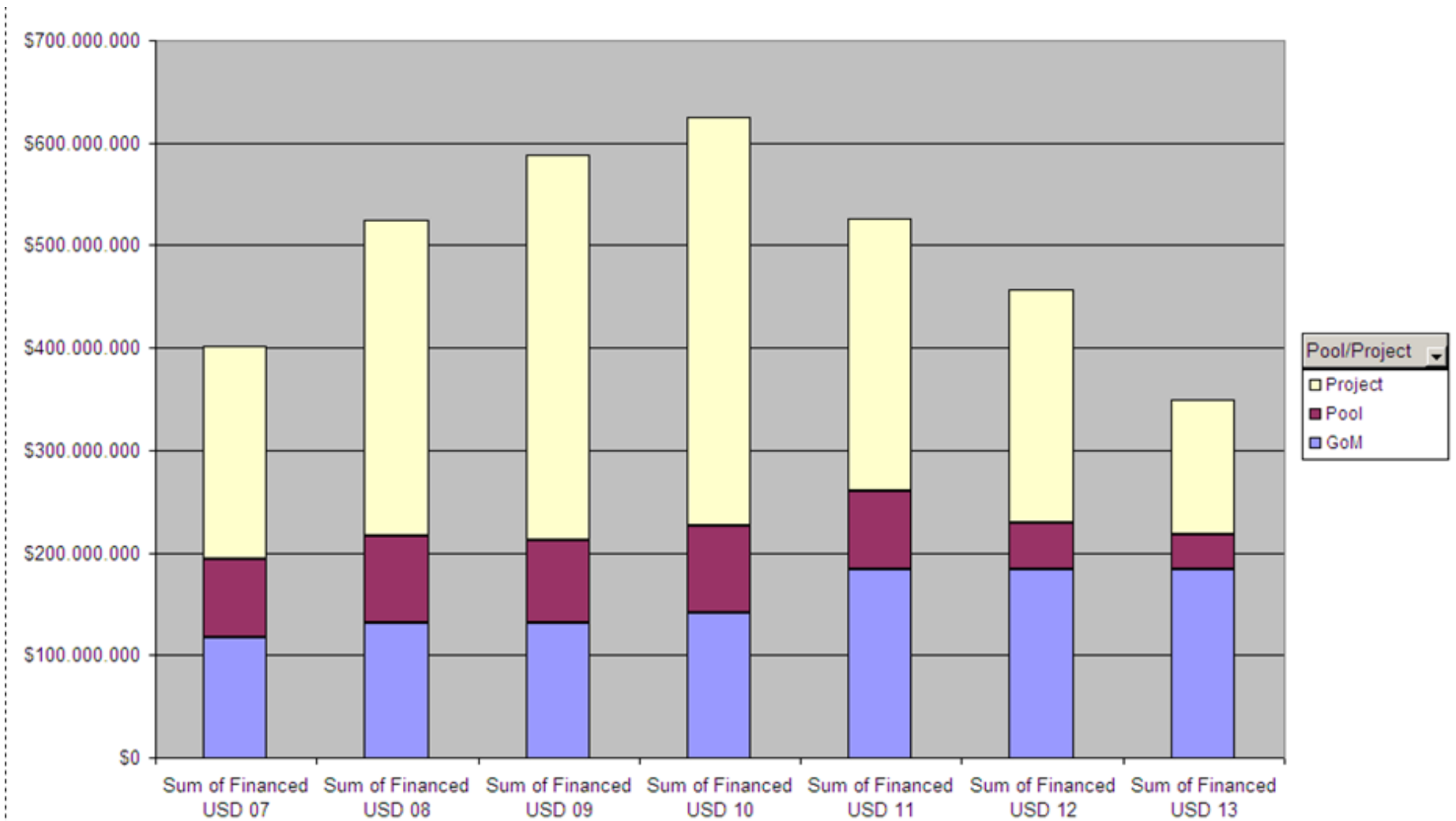

Background

- On Health SWAP since 2000
- IHP+ Country compact signed in 2008
- Pooled Funds arrangement (30 -50 % of funding in the health sector) with still vertical funds
- Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed by 13 donors
- 5 Year Government Plan
- Poverty Reduction Strategy
- Health Sector Strategic Plan 2007-12
- Several disease or program specific plans finalized

Health Sector performance and evaluation processes

- Joint Annual review of previous year performance basis for financial commitments
 - ▣ Joint Annual review with TORs, review of selected set of indicators, joint analysis of results...
 - ▣ Joint Agreed list of indicators,
 - ▣ Performance assessment framework of Government plan and partners commitments

But.....

1. Institutional capacity is currently weak and not integrated, especially in the areas of data quality assessment, analysis and synthesis and linkage to programmatic decision making and strategic planning
2. Buy in of some key partners still weak, partners who tends to propose parallel systems

Ongoing process

At Macro level : development of the Poverty Reduction Strategy Paper 2011-14

- ✓ Joint WHO/Global Fund / USG / WB mission visited Mozambique in July 2010, on the request from MoH to assist in developing a comprehensive M&E component of the national health plan
- ✓ The mission held consultations with major stakeholders , Ministry of Health and in Country institutions and partners
- ✓ Produced a report with recommendations to be addressed in short mid and long term that were endorsed by MoH
- ✓ Joint Intermediate provisional M&E plan based on the existing plans, indicators and review processes:
 - ▣ ToRs approved in and process in ongoing with involvement all MoH directorates
- ✓ Capacity building of a team from Mozambique at the M&E platform Workshop in Cape Town, October 2010.

Next Steps

- Consultation Roadmap for the Mid term review/ Final Evaluation of the Health Sector Strategic Plan 2007-2012 in 2011.
- Conduct a needs assessment on M/E existing capacities
- National Capacity building Workshop on “country M&E platform“ involving the major partners/institution involved in production, and analysis of data.
- Policy consultation process to develop new health sector plan with a comprehensive M&E component in 2011.
