CS involvement in the GF

Geneva

Representation of CS in the GFATM

1. International level: CS in the GF Board
(decision making – 3 seats & voting right)
2. National level: CS in CCMs
(national partnership & oversight – 40% CS)

Responsibilities & term

Principles:

- CCMs and Board Constituencies determine their own processes (based on some agreed guidelines)
- Open, transparent, documented processes
- CS Board member terms in practice: 1 – 2 years

Mandate on Board

Defined by:

- a. By-laws
- b. Constituency processes (consultation & accountability mechanism)

Need for improvement:

- *Strengthen these mechanism*
- *Strengthen support of BM*
- *Establish collaboration between CS global health reps*

Level of influence

1. Voting rights & balance of votes
2. Distinct role of CS
3. The voice of the people

Financial & technical support

- Basic cost covered by GF for BM, Alternate and CFP
- No coverage of delegation cost

How effective has CS been?

- CS has shown concrete results in GF model
- GF model provides a standard
